Initial Each Statement

- 1. I will not operate a government vehicle unless properly dispatched.
- 2. I will not operate a government vehicle without availd license for the type of vehicle which I am required to operate.
- 3. I will operate all government vehicles in compliance with ALL on and off post traffic and safety regulations, and in compliance with applicable federal and local civilian laws.
- 4. I acknowledge that I am responsible for all vehicles dispatched in my name. I am directly responsible for proper loading and unloading of all cargo vehicles.
- 5. I will only operate government vehicles for the execution of official business. I understand that any person operating or authorizing the operation of a vehicle for any reason other than official use is subject to punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice.
- 6. I will not leave any government vehicle unattended without engaging all manufactured or locally fabricated locking devices installed on the vehicle.
- 7. If involved in an accident, regardless of fault, I understand that I am required to contact my first line supervisor IMMEDIATELY.
- 8. If involved in an accident, regardless of fault, I understand that I am required to notify the Directorate of Emergency Services. If operable, I am required to turn the vehicle in to the Commercially Leased Vehicle Branch within 24 hours of incident. There are no exceptions to this policy.
- 9. I will drive safely and defensively at all times, making every effort to avoid accidents. I will always yield the right of way to other vehicles when in doubt.
- 10. I will wear my seatbelt at all times. I will not smoke, drink, use drugs, alcohol, or cellular devices while operating a government vehicle.
